9:05am APPROVAL OF AUGUST MINUTES

Motion to approve the August meeting minutes by Hoban second by Owens, Motion passes unanimously.

9:10am DISCUSSION

9:10am (30 min) Eagle Land Use and Development Code presentation

- This fall, the Town of Eagle has begun the process of a minor update to Chapter 3 of the 2020 Elevate Eagle Comprehensive Plan (Comp Plan) to better reflect the community's current needs.
- The update will focus on the Comp Plan's Future Land Use Map.
- The Town is working with a consulting firm to complete the update.
- The consultant presented to the Committee and solicited initial feedback regarding open space and trails.
- The consultant will continue collaborating with the Committee throughout the process.
- The Code updated will be an ongoing development.

9:40am (30 min) Trail maintenance budgeting discussion

- The Committee discussed current trail maintenance strategies for Town and nearby trails.
- In addition, the Committee brainstormed ideas for providing ongoing trail maintenance.
- There was consent on the Committee that the Open Space and Trails Master Plan will be the best tool to help guide trail maintenance priorities, budgeting, and strategies.

10:10am (10 min) Open Space and Trails Master Plan update

- The first focus group for the Open Space and Trails Master Plan will be September 23, 2021. Renata with Eagle Valley Outdoor Movement will be there to translate for Spanish attendees.
- The first open house will follow on October 19, 2021, at the Brush Creek Pavilion. More details to come.
- Everyone who signed up for the email list will be notified of the first open house. Additional advertising will occur on the trail advocacy groups' websites, the Town's social media platforms, the Vail Daily, and around town.
- The open house will be structured with several stations where attendees can learn about open space and trails and provide feedback.

10:20am (5 min) Ongoing projects update (LOV Bridge and Haymaker)

- VVMTA's TCC is partnering with the Town to take the lead on remodeling the LOV Connection Bridge. A site visit to the bridge is scheduled for September, and materials will be purchased shortly after.
- Materials for the Haymaker fence will arrive next week. The fence should be completed by the end of September. This is the last remaining outstanding project for the 2021 Haymaker Trailhead updates.

10:25am (5 min) Future Agenda items/ New Business

1. The first High School race will take place on September 24-26. The second race is on October 8-10. The Haymaker trail will be closed during the races. Maintenance will be completed on the trail ahead of the first race.
2. The Committee briefly discussed the wheeled closure on Hardscrabble Road and how that will interface with the new Adam's Way trail. Town and County staff will collaborate with the Forest Service to discuss potential solutions that avoid sending bikes on Brush Creek Road.
