Policy Workplan

1. Commitment and schedule for contacting top employers
2. Finalize Economic Development Benchmarks to use in data collection
3. Review DCI Community Assessment Draft and prioritize action items.
4. Helping to prepare for DOLA Rural Economic Development Initiative \$100,000 Grant
 1. Deadline is ~ March 15, 2020.
 2. Planning grant for market research/ viability of Outdoor Rec Economy in Eagle
 3. “Projects supporting community, economic or workforce development are potentially eligible for REDI assistance. Projects that support entrepreneurship, leverage private investment or public/private partnerships (e.g. innovation centers, co-working spaces, maker-spaces, business expansion and scaling up) could be eligible.
