3. Discuss rescheduling November 11, 2025 Town Council Meeting

4. Discuss policy for memorial dedications on Town property.

Assistant Town Manager Michelle Daruna presented this item, asking for the Council's thoughts on creating a town policy on memorial dedications. Staff were directed to explore potential policies, including input from the Historical Society, and bring back recommendations for Council consideration.

The Council discussed the need for funding for National Night Out, with the Town Manager and Finance Director identifying potential funding sources to ensure the event is covered.
